

**Life Chain – Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup> ~ 2:00 – 3:30 p.m.** Life Chain is a peaceful and prayerful witness of pro-life individuals standing with pro-life signs for 90 minutes on Broadway from 16<sup>th</sup> to 35<sup>th</sup> Street in Council Bluffs. It is a visual statement of solidarity by the Christian community that abortion kills children and that the Church supports the sanctity of human life from conception until natural death.
