Kantor's Notes: Today's hymnody is characterized by the joy that is ours in the Christ made manifest. The opening and closing hymns make explicit mention of Christ's first miracle at the wedding at Cana (LSB 399:4 & LSB 394:2), where Christ by His miracle brought a couple abundant joy. The remaining hymns were chosen to emphasize the joy that Christ brings to His bride the church. LSB 636, for example, not only contains Bride/Bridegroom imagery but also expresses the resulting joy that comes from Christ. LSB 395 describes our present joy ("O let the harps break forth in sound! Our joy be all with music crowned..."), as well as the joy we have in our future home of heaven (st. 6). The remaining Communion distribution hymns are so full of joy that they even have the word *joy* in their titles (LSB 387 & LSB 803)! Even the appointed hymn of the day (LSB 402), while it doesn't use the word *joy*, certainly characterizes our joyful faith-filled response to Christ, our bright "Morning Star" (see stanza 3 especially). Consider meditating on these hymns during today's prelude and offertory!
